
WPD publishes new flexibility requirements totalling 93.4MW

A procurement timeline has also been published;

- 4 February flexibility zones were published
- 19 March ITT issued to all participants who have registered their interest and passed a pre-qualification stage
- 22 April ITT deadline
- 13 May Procurement results.

Western Power Distribution (WPD) has published its intention to procure 93.4MW of new demand response services via its Flexible Power brand.

The 93.4MW is across 12 zones, which all have a need within 2019/20. WPD has also signposted ongoing needs to 2023/24.

A postcode checker is available to help interested parties determine if they have a suitable site inside these zones.

Full details of the requirements in each zone have been published on the Flexible Power website, www.flexiblepower.co.uk. The information includes: zone locations, which months each zone needs flexibility, the required availability windows and the MWhs needed within each month. procurement in July 2019.
