IronPigs' 'Go Green Night' marks the 75th anniversary of first major league baseball night game

Fans of the [Lehigh Valley IronPigs](#) will experience more than just a baseball game when they cheer on the home team Monday night (5/24). - Room air conditioners work best when they are not exposed to the sun. Install your air conditioner on the north side of the house or take advantage of shade from trees. PPL Electric Utilities has rebates for ENERGY STAR room air conditioners, as well as other energy-efficient heating and cooling systems.
